



## STUDENT INFORMATION FORM

If you need a letter of recommendation for your college application, a scholarship program, etc., please complete this form and **INCLUDE AS MUCH INFORMATION AS POSSIBLE.** Remember that the person writing your recommendation wants to do a good job for you but needs your assistance.

It is very important that you return this completed form to the person writing your recommendation **AT LEAST TWO WEEKS BEFORE YOU NEED THE RECOMMENDATION.** Waiting until the last minute to furnish the writer information could result in disappointment for you!

### **BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR INFORMATION FORM CHECK THE FOLLOWING:**

- \* Ask your counselor when would be a good time to meet and turn in your information form.
- \* Bring a white business-size envelope for EACH college which a letter of recommendation is required.

Address EACH envelope for EACH college.

Place a postage stamp on EACH envelope.

Counselor will stamp SSHS return address for you.

\* Bring in completed application or counselor's section of the application (Bring it in within two working weeks in advance of the application deadline).

\* Must waive "Right to Access" if on the application. On certain application a confidential "waiver of Rights" statement is enclosed. You must sign this waiver form that indicates that all rights of access to all information and material of any kind received by the university regarding your application are voluntarily waived by you. (If this waiver is NOT signed, many admissions Officers with NOT acknowledge your counselor's Letter of Recommendation!)
